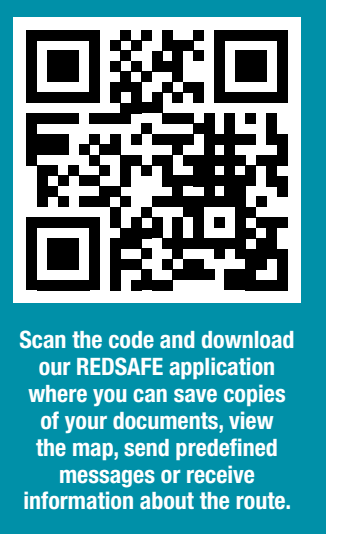

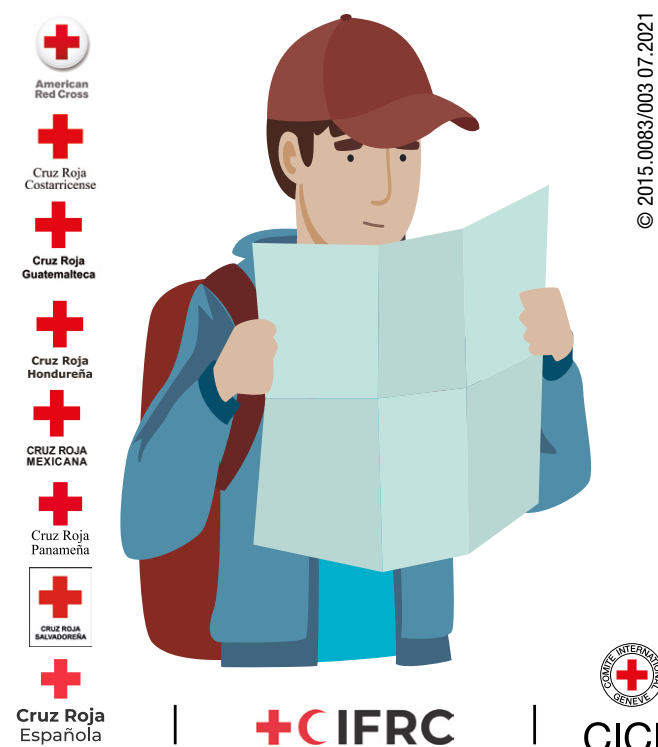




## Useful information

- Before setting off, be sure to have checked routes and distances, transport options, safe shelters and weather conditions along the route.** Note down the contact details of your country's embassies and other useful organizations in case you need their help.  
Remember that you will encounter a range of weather conditions during your journey, which may be extreme. Take appropriate clothing and be prepared for any eventuality, including poisonous or dangerous animals.
- For your own safety, don't share any information about your journey or your family with strangers.** Don't say anything about having friends or relatives in the United States and don't say if someone is providing you with financial support. **Someone could use this information to extort money from you.**

- If you have a mobile phone, do not lend it to strangers or to anyone you do not fully trust.** If they access your list of contacts, this could put you in danger.
- It is generally safer to travel during the day and in a group, especially for women. Try to stay with your group.**
- Find safe places to spend the night.** It is usually extremely dangerous to sleep outdoors. Make sure you pack a torch.
- Your journey will be dangerous.** Extortion and robbery are common, even when travelling by train or other modes of transport. **Never leave your belongings unattended.**
- If the authorities detain you, keep calm** and listen to their instructions.
- Leave a copy or photograph of your official identification document with a recent photograph of yourself and/or your fingerprint** with someone you trust in your country of origin. Do the same for any children who are travelling with you.
- If you want to return voluntarily to your own country, contact or visit the International Organization for Migration (IOM) (+52 55 1910 5599 / +52 55 2690 4314).** They offer a free-of-charge assisted voluntary return programme.

- If you are the victim of a crime in Mexico, or you witness one, you have the right to begin the process of regularization for humanitarian reasons, the right to receive legal advice and the right to receive medical attention.** Important: You must report the crime in order to be able to access these rights. If you find yourself in this situation, contact the Executive Commission for Victim Care (Comisión Ejecutiva de Atención a Víctimas or CEAV) on **+52 55 1000 2000**

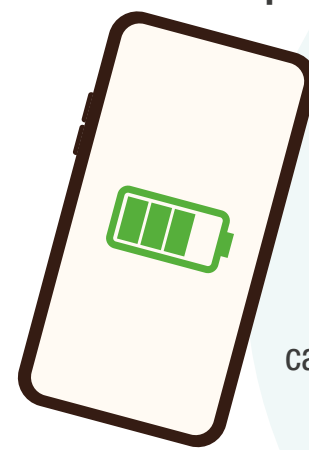


- In Mexico, only the National Migration Institute (Instituto Nacional de Migración) may ask to check your immigration status. No other authority may demand to see your documents or detain you if the immigration authorities are not present. If you are concerned about how you have been treated by the authorities, you can call the CNDH (National Human Rights Commission) on **+52 55 5681 8125**
- Mexican law prohibits the detention of children and adolescents in immigration detention centres. They must be sent, together with their family members, to institutions designated for children.**

## Keeping in contact with your family

- During your journey, **keep in touch with your family and let them know the following:**
  - your precise current location
  - with whom you are travelling
  - your next destination point
  - when you will next contact them.
- Remember that **some shelters and Red Cross stations provide an internet connection, free phone calls and battery charging points.** Try to make use of these services to contact your friends and family, especially before crossing a border.

- If you are travelling with a trusted group of people, **agree on what to do if you lose contact with each other during the journey.** Also agree on what to do in dangerous situations, including if someone is detained, disappears, has an accident or dies. Remember that you can seek help at a shelter or from the Red Cross. You can help a person's family know what has happened to their loved one.
- Switch off your mobile phone or **put it in airplane mode to save battery as you will go for long periods** without being able to recharge it. Consider taking a portable battery pack. Only use your mobile phone to make essential calls and keep it in a plastic bag when not in use.

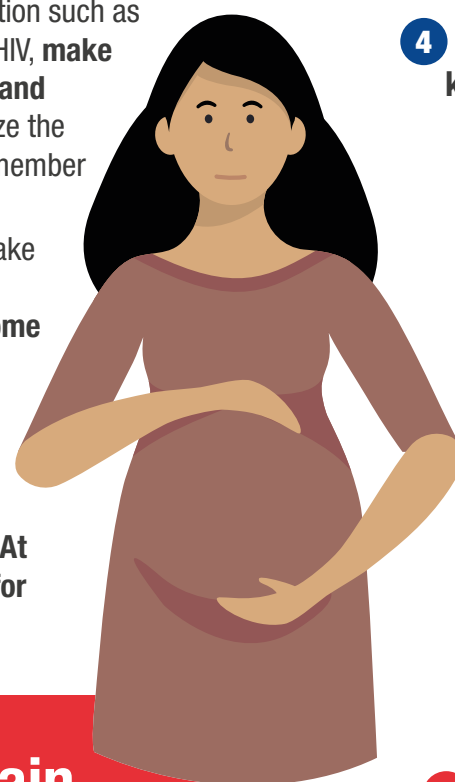


- Only use a mobile phone of someone you trust where possible. If you do use a stranger's phone, delete your call from their call history when you finish.**
- If you are travelling with a child or adolescent, make sure they memorize your personal details and phone number.** Make a plan of what to do if you lose contact. If they are too young to memorize these details, **give them a card with your information and put it somewhere safe.** This will help you to be reunited if you become separated.

## Looking after your health

- If you have a chronic health condition such as diabetes, high blood pressure or HIV, **make sure you take your medication and prescriptions with you.** Memorize the name of each medication and remember to keep taking it. If you are using contraception, make sure you take it with you. **Free contraception is available at some health-care centres and Red Cross stations.**
- In hospitals and health-care centres, **you have the right to free emergency health care.** At the end of your check-up, ask for information about your state of



health and for a copy of your medical records. In case of emergency in Mexico and the United States, dial 911. You can also seek assistance from the Red Cross.

- Make sure you know your blood group and carry this information with you.
- If you are detained, let the authorities know if you have a health condition or illness or if you need medication.** As a detainee, you have the right to medical treatment. It will help if you can clearly explain what medication you are taking and show them your prescriptions.
- To prevent dehydration, drink water regularly or take rehydration drinks.** This is especially important if you are pregnant. **Do not drink stagnant water or tap water. Protect yourself from the sun with a hat and appropriate clothing.**

- Pack a plastic drinking bottle that you can reuse. You can refill it at Red Cross stations and at drinking water points.**



- If you are experiencing symptoms such as a fever, cough, body aches, vomiting or diarrhoea, go immediately to a health-care centre where you will be seen free of charge.**
- Always remember to take the following three steps to prevent infectious disease: wash your hands frequently, wear a face mask, use mosquito repellent and/or wear long-sleeved tops.

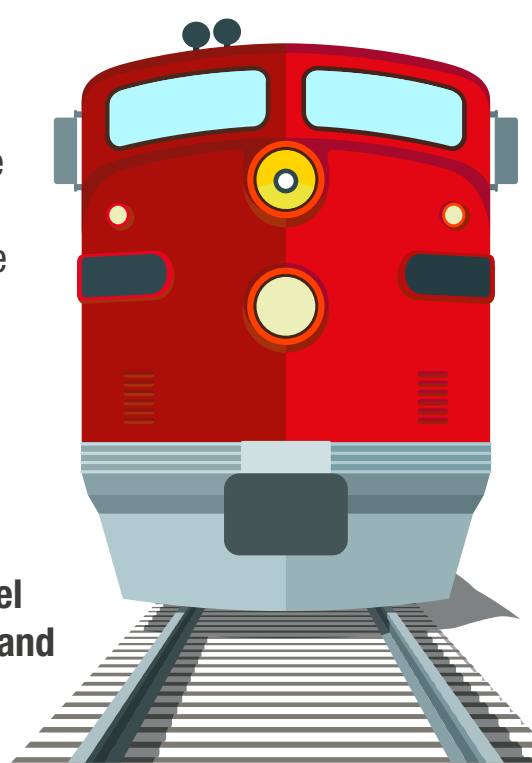
- Carry your vaccination booklet with you to show your vaccination status for COVID-19 and other illnesses.**
- Do not wear damp shoes or socks as they can cause blisters and skin infections. Make sure you pack an extra pair of socks and a pair of light plastic shoes.** Cotton socks and talcum powder can also help prevent blisters.



- Sexual violence is a medical emergency that requires immediate attention. Visiting a health-care centre within 72 hours after the incident could save your life.** The Red Cross can help you with transport and psychological support. In case of emergency in Mexico and the United States, dial 911.

## Travelling by train or other vehicle

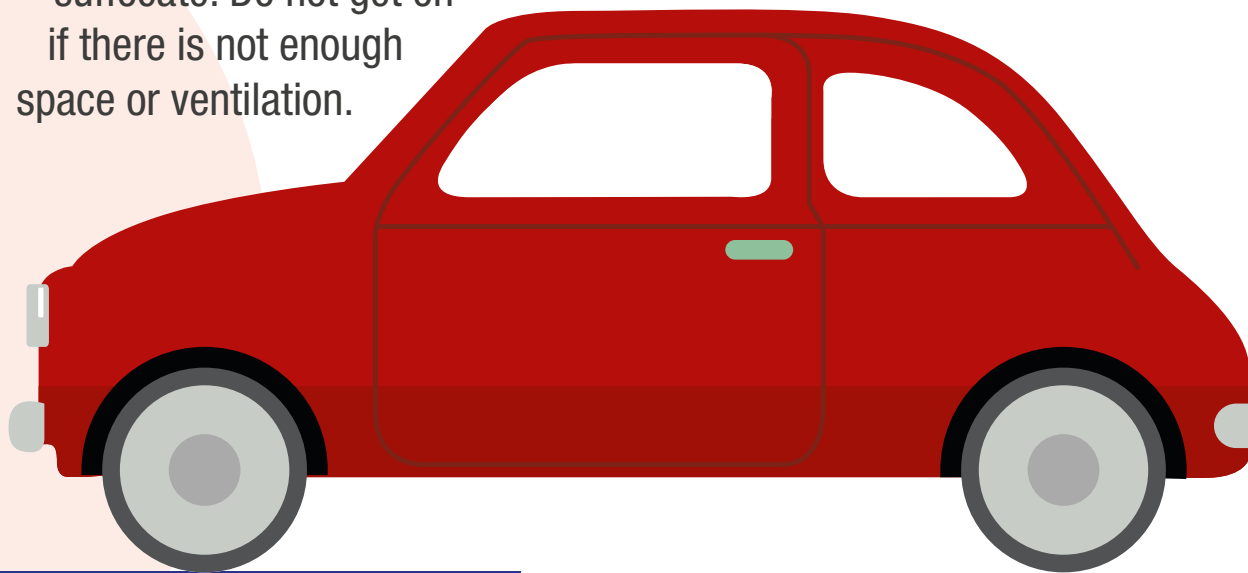
- Avoid getting on to a freight train or vehicle if you have not eaten or rested, or if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication that can make you drowsy. **If you go to sleep, you could fall. Take it in turns with your travel companions to rest and watch each other.**



- Do not tie items of clothing around your waist, as they could get caught on something and cause you serious injury. Do not carry a bag or any other items in your hands.**
- While onboard a freight train or any other freight vehicle, it is recommended that you remain seated. Be careful and look out for any branches, electrical cables or tunnels that could hit you or cause you to fall. Sit where you can hold on to something.



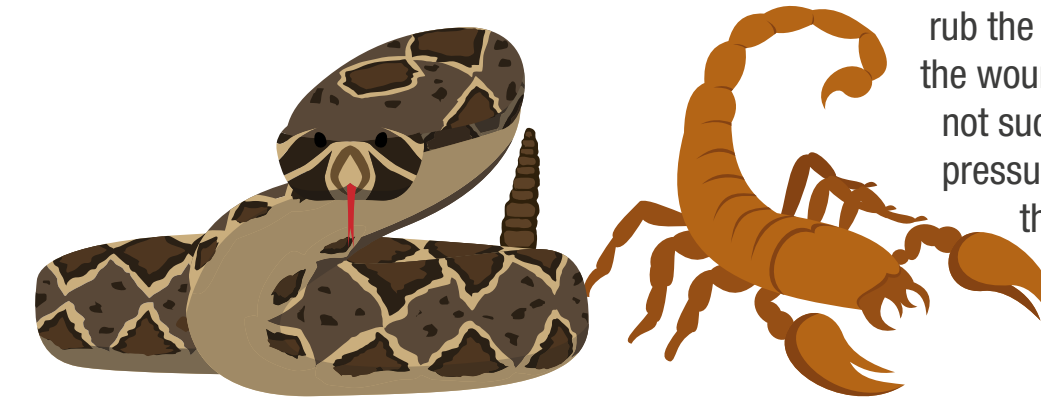
- Avoid getting on to a freight train or other freight vehicle with children.
- Do not travel in vehicles or small spaces** with lots of people where you may suffocate. Do not get on if there is not enough space or ventilation.



- If a stranger offers to take you somewhere, carefully assess the risks and check what type of vehicle you would travel in. **Do not agree to travel in an enclosed vehicle where you cannot get out by yourself.**

## Walking through woodland, a forest or a desert

- In places with hot climates, you may encounter **poisonous animals, such as scorpions, spiders and snakes.** Bites or stings from these animals can kill you.



- Shake out your clothes, shoes and rucksack before using them and check the area where you will sit or sleep** to avoid bites and stings. Use insect repellent to help prevent being stung or bitten.
- If an animal bites or stings you, seek immediate medical attention. Do not rub the affected area and rinse the wound with clean water. Do not suck out the venom or put pressure on the affected area: this will only cause more harm and increase the risk of infection.

- Put all of your documents in a plastic bag that is attached to your clothes to prevent them from getting lost or wet.**

- Rivers are much deeper than they seem.** Crossing them while wearing lots of clothes or with a rucksack can reduce your mobility. You can easily drown in currents and whirlpools.
- In the desert, you will encounter extreme temperatures:** extreme heat in the day and extreme cold at night. Remember to travel with enough drinking water or rehydration drinks to avoid getting dehydrated. Wear trousers, long-sleeved tops and a head covering to protect yourself from the sun. Also take warm clothing, gloves, a torch and matches with you.

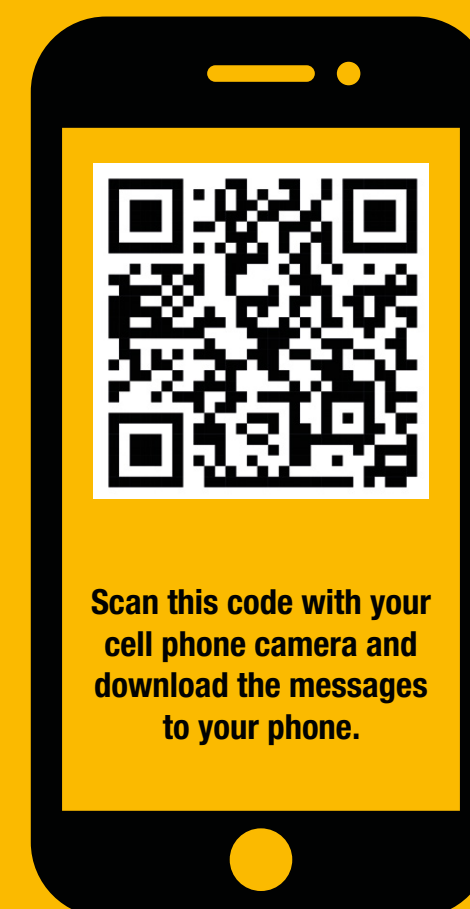
